How to Spritz In 6 steps

1. Add Water

Add water to the fill line. Overfilling the bottle will result in spraying water.



2. Insert a capsule


a. Remove the sticker from the capsule.

b. Place the capsule into the end cap. Thread it into the Aer1 device extra tight.

Pro tip: If capsules are warm, cool them before using. Capsules may be refrigerated.




3. Screw the device on

Screw the device on. Ensure it is threaded tightly and you can no longer see the gray o-ring.




4. Tap the button

Tap the button until you hear the device vent pressure. This is the relief valve opening. At times mist will accompany pressurized air.



5. Shake your bottle

Shake your bottle for about three seconds.



6. Repeat steps 4 & 5

Spritz (Tap and shake)

two more times


to reach your desired carbonation level. Each time you tap and shake, the beverage will become more carbonated.

Customizing your carbonation and matching your preferences is simple. Simply adjust the number of spritzes:

Efficiency Guide

Want better results?

Each capsule should make 4 bottles (2L) of sparkling water when used according to this guide.



Always use **cold water** (45° or below). The colder the better.



Always add water exactly to the fill line.



Always **tap the button** instead of pressing and holding.



Shake vigorously after spritzing to better mix the water & CO₂.


Other Uses

Preserve your water

If you want to drink half a bottle and save the rest for later:

- **1.** Screw the Aer1 device onto your bottle containing previously carbonated water.
- 2. Tap the button two times.

This will re-pressurize your bottle, keeping the sparkling water fresh for later.



Other Uses

Re-carbonating water

If your water has gone fully or partially flat:

Simply fill the bottle back to the fill line and carbonate according to the guide starting on page 6.

If your water still has carbonation left, it will take less gas (and therefore fewer button taps) to achieve your desired result.



Disassemble device

Remove end cap; if you have a capsule in your device, remove it and set it aside.




How to Clean

Hand wash device

Wash device with mild soap and water. Rinse and allow to fully dry before use.


Swapping & Refilling

How to swap


Unscrew end cap & remove empty capsule.



Swap with a fresh one from capsule holder.



Remove the sticker and place into the end cap. Screw the end cap on to the device tightly.




Managing your capsules




Every Aerflo System comes with extra capsules, so you will never be without. Transfer new capsules from your refill pack to your capsule holder. Exchange empty capsules with full ones from your refill pack. When your refill pack contains only empties, it's time to return.

How & when to refill

1. Swap empties for full capsules from your refill pack. When it's full, it's ready to return.



2. To prepare for shipping, peel the backing from the flap and firmly press the lid closed.



How & when to refill

3. Drop the box at any USPS pickup location. (e.g. mailbox, office, doorman, post office)




4. When USPS scans the label, a new pack is shipped to you along with a confirmation email. Shipping time is usually 5-7 days.



How we refill

After receiving your refill pack with empties, our automated facility counts, cleans, inspects, refills, and inspects again to prepare capsules for the next customer. Due to this, capsules in a refill pack will not always look brand new, but are always clean and cleared for use.



Do

Only use with Aerflo bottle or compatible bottles listed at aerflo.co/compatible.

Use only plain water.

Add any flavor only after spritzing plain water.

The Aer1 is hand-wash only. Keep the device and the Carbon Capsules in a cool, dry place. Always remove the sticker from a capsule prior to use.

If the Carbon Capsules are warm to the touch, cool the Carbon Capsules by running cold water over them or placing in the fridge.

Cool the device and Carbon Capsules immediately if any component is hot.

If the top rubber component fills with air or domes up in any way, stop using the product immediately and contact us at hello@aerflo.co.

Do not



WARNING! The T.S.A. does not allow carbon capsules in any baggage on an airplane.

Do not use Aer1 System with liquids above 120°F/50°C. Exposure to heat may cause damage to the device or injury to yourself.

Do not place any component of the Aer1 System in a dishwasher. Hand wash only. (See page 20)

Do not tamper with, refill or expose Carbon Capsules to heat, open flames, or direct sunlight for extended periods.

Do not use the Aer1 device or Carbon Capsules if warm to the touch. Cool before use.

Do not use a bottle that is badly dented or damaged.

Do not use with liquids other than water.


Do not use if the Aer1 device or Carbon Capsules are visibly cracked or damaged.

Do not place either Aer1 device or Carbon Capsules in the microwave or freezer.

Do not expose the aer1 system to sunscreen.



WARNING! If cap balloons during use, stop use and relieve all pressure immediately.



Remove the capsule and confirm the sticker has been removed.

Confirm the bottom cap is screwed tightly.

Cool all components.

If none of the steps above solves the issue, the device is broken. Please contact hello@aerflo.co to exchange your cap.

Q: How many bottles does each capsule make? A: Each capsule makes four bottles when used according to the guide.

Q: Why do I need to shake my bottle after tapping the button?

A: Shaking your bottle helps the water and CO₂ mix. This is a necessary step to get the most out of your system.

Q: I pressed the button and I did not hear a valve sound. What happened?

A: As you empty a capsule there is less pressure in the system and sometimes not enough to trigger the relief system. Press the button until the capsule is empty and swap in a new capsule

if needed.

Q: Is it ok if there is mist coming out of the cap when I am carbonating water?

A: Due to the mixing process, slight mist is unavoidable. If you're experiencing a lot of water, this is a side effect of overfilling your bottle. Adjust your water level to the fill line and try again. Additionally it can be a side effect of capsules being too warm. Try cooling them before use, or storing them in the fridge.

Q: If I want to add flavor, how do I do that?

A: Add flavor (power packets, flavor syrup, fresh fruit) only after you have carbonated plain water.

Q: Can I carbonate less than a full bottle of water?

A: Technically you can, but it is a huge waste of CO₂ as it is very inefficient.

Q: How much pressure does this device generate in my bottle?

A: 45 PSI when used as guided.

Q: The Aer1 is a little bit difficult for me to press

A: If you find pushing the button difficult, hold your bottle at the bottom or place it on a flat surface. Use your thumb or your first two fingers to press down on the button. If that does not work, try cooling the capsules under cool water or in the refrigerator

FAQs

Q: Can I spritz with ice in the bottle?

A: Yes, we recommend letting the ice cool your water first.

Q: Why do I need to shake each bottle after spritzing?

A: Shaking helps the water and CO2 mix. This is a necessary step to get the best efficiency per capsule.

Q: I tapped the button on my Aer1, but my bottle is empty. Is it safe to open?

A: Yes! This is completely safe and there is no need for concern. You'll just hear a release of the CO2 that was built up in the bottle.

Q: I think something is wrong with my Aer1, what should I do?

A: Please reach out to the customer experience team at hello@aerflo.co and they will help you troubleshoot any issues you might have.
